GENERAL REGULATIONS 2010

Art. 0

The participants chose the new leader of AA working group,- Mr. Silvin Vesenjajk.

Art. 1

The AA Motorcycle Union organises for the year 2010 the individual ALPE ADRIA EUROPEAN REGIONAL ENDURO CHAMPIONSHIP (6 events= 11 rounds) and ALPE ADRIA NATIONS CHAMPIONSHIP for National Teams (two day event).

Art. 2

To participate in these events a rider must be owner of a licence of a country which is a member of ALPE ADRIA MOTORCYCLE UNION , together with the starting permission.The events will be held under the General Regulations and the UEM or FIM rules.

Art. 4

The classes will be as follows :

E 1 (to 125 cc 2 T + to 250 cc 4 T)

E 2 (from 175 cc 2 T to 250 cc 2 T + from 290 cc to 450 cc 4 T)

E 3 (from 290 cc to 500 cc 2 T + from 475 cc to 650 cc 4 T)

JUNIOR – riders under 23 years (or who will be 23 years in the year of competition)

VETERANS – riders over 40 years (40 years on 1. 1. of the current year)

Art. 5

For the final individual classification points of all rounds are considered , -1 round .

Art. 6

For the class VETERAN, only on Saturday , is foreseen 1 lap less than other classes.

The colour of the number plate is YELLOW , numbers are BLACK – for all AA classes.

The overtime limit is fixed at 30 minutes more than that marked on the time card.

Art. 7

Only tyres with F.I.M ENDURO inscription (on rear tyre depth of thread is maximum 13 mm) are allowed .

Art. 8

The event of AA enduro championship can take place together with other races , but with separated classification.

Art. 9

The events of AA enduro championship is normally a two day event , but a race organized in Italy is a one day event.

Art. 10

The administrative verification for the riders will take place on Friday, Saturday and Sunday .

Art. 11

In every lap there must take place at least 2 special tests : if possible one cross test and one enduro test .The E.T. of the first lap on Saturday will not be timed.

Art.12

The organizer must send to the AAMU Secretary the race classifications by class , each day separately.

Drivers announcement must be sent to the organizer 7 days before each event.

Art. 14

The entry fee maximum is 60,00 EURO or corresponding value in other currencies according to the daily exchange rates.

The entry fee must reach the organizer trough the administrative verifications.

70,00 EURO will pay drivers who did not announce 7 days before each event.

Art. 15

The Supplementary Regulations shall be sent (two paper copies and one e-mail copy) to the AA executive Secretariat for approval , not later than 1 month before the event , who sends SR to all the AA FMN.

Art. 16

The twenty best riders classified in each class will be awarded with points according to the following scale at the end of each day of the competition.

Place: 1 2 3 4 5 6 7 8 9 10 11 12 13 14 15 16 17 18 19 20
Points: 25 22 20 18 16 15 14 13 12 11 10 9 8 7 6 5 4 3 2 1

Art. 17

The organizer gives prizes at least to the first 3 riders in each class.

Art. 18

The use of an environment mat (size 200 x 100 cm) , or other effective device , is obligatory to be used where servicing of machines is permitted by the organizer.

Art. 19

For what is not specified in these General regulations the rules of the UEM and FIM code have validity.

Art. 20

The regulations for AA nations championship will be done separately and will be prepared by AA enduro commission per e-mail , until 30.6.2010
